OUR COMMUNITY HAS DONE IT AGAIN!!

After the Richland Area Community Center installed solar panels last fall, more and more people are getting inspired and are transitioning to renewables.

Today, we celebrate the story of Chris and Nancy Lawrence who have been farming and involved in helping others farm all their life. The story begins in 1991 when they bought a 40-acre farm in Hickory Corners. They are involved in a USDA program for pollinator habitat to support bees and butterflies, in addition to raising calves. For a long time they have been heating their home and shop with an outdoor boiler fueled by wood. This year they decided to install solar panels on their garage roof to provide 80% of the energy their farm, shop and home consume. By doing this Chris and Nancy will be getting a tax credit and will save a lot of money on the electricity bill while helping our environment thrive.

Chris and Nancy are not just helping in the conservation of bees and butterflies; they are also keeping the air we breathe cleaner by transitioning their farm to renewable energies. They are showing us that change is possible!!
