Day 1 – Sunday, June 14, 2026

Continue on to Pittsburgh, arriving in time to ride the historic **Duquesne Incline**, a century-old cable car that climbs Mount Washington for sweeping views of the city skyline. Tonight's farewell dinner is a special experience at the beautifully restored **Pittsburgh & Lake Erie Railroad Station**, now the **Grand Concourse Restaurant at Station Square**. Overnight: Sheraton Pittsburgh Hotel at Station Square
