Day 1- Thursday, August 20, 2026

See the home Lucy was born in and visit her burial site. We will also tour the **Lucy Desi Museum** and see original props, scripts, costumes and much more. Enjoy a buffet lunch at **The Tropicana Room**. After lunch we will tour the **National Comedy Center**. The Center features over 50 immersive exhibits that take you on a laugh-filled, interactive journey through the world of comedy. After a quick stop at the hotel to freshen up, we will depart for a **pre-dinner cruise** aboard the **Chautauqua Belle**. One of just four steamboats still operating in the country. Day 3 – Saturday August 22, 2026

We depart for a guided tour of the Dunkirk Lighthouse, one of Lake Erie’s oldest lighthouses. We can see the wedding dress made from two WWII parachutes that four local sisters were married in, along with other military memorabilia. The view from the top of the tower is a must see. After the tour we will head to the **Liberty Winery** for lunch and wine tasting. After lunch we will check into the **Fairfield Inn & Suites Finger Lakes** in Geneva, NY. Dinner is included and you see beautiful views of Seneca Lake at the **41 Lakefront Hotel**. B, L, D

Day 4- Sunday August 23, 2026

This morning, we will have a guided tour of the **Corning Museum of Glass** in Corning, NY. The museum is dedicated to the art, history and science of glass, with a collection of more than 50,000 glass objects, some over 3,500 years old. After the tour you will have lunch on your own at the **Corning Museum of Glass Café**. After lunch we will have a tour of the **Rockwell Museum**. The Rockwell Museum is a Smithsonian Affiliate Museum of American Art. This afternoon we will board our boat at **Captain Bill’s** to enjoy a **scenic cruise on Seneca Lake**, the largest of the Finger Lakes. We will discover the beauty and charm of Seneca Lake as it can only be seen from the water. After the cruise we will have dinner on the lake at **Seneca Harbor Station** offering breathtaking views of the water and majestic landscapes surrounding it. B, D

Day 5 – Monday August 24, 2026

Today we will start with the beautiful **Sonnenburg Gardens**. Sonnenberg Gardens is a New York State Historic Park, offering one of the few remaining estates with a **Queen Anne Victorian-style mansion and formal gardens** in America. We will have lunch at **Belhurst Castle**. The property that surrounds Belhurst Castle was originally the site of a Seneca Indian village and home to the Council of the Six Nations of Iroquois. After lunch we will visit the **Finger Lakes Welcome Center**. See why the Finger Lakes are known for food, wine, and of course, lakes. Wine tasting is included during our stop here as well. After a quick stop back to our hotel to refresh, we will have our final dinner, and one last wine tasting at the stunning **Ventosa Vineyard**. Their mission is Excellence!! Every soup, dressing and sauce is homemade on the day of our event. B,L,D
